The integrative arts are a powerful instrument for social change and inclusion, since they are both pleasant and useful for the involved participants at the individual, group, and communal levels and have the potential to produce influential messages to the general public.

Activities:

The mobility aims to emphasize on the effect of collective creative processes as a tool for social inclusion and integration. We will have interactive games, discussions energizers, workshops on integrative arts, etc. The activities will start at 20th August in the morning and end at 24th August in the evening. 19th and 25th August are travel days. There will be artistic workshops delivered by every group during the mobility. In the last day of the mobility participants will take part in public event in Velingrad.

The methods we use are based on non-formal education and are highly participatory.

Every partner selects 5 participants 18-30 y.o. and one group leader 18+ years old.

Participant profile:

- Being between the ages of 18-30;



- To be able to express themselves in English;
- Be active at all stages of activities,
- Will not hesitate to express himself / herself in an international environment;
- Take responsibility in group work;
- Contribute to the dissemination of the project with the knowledge and experiences acquired;

Special Profile of Participants:

- Integrative arts related or experienced;
- To carry out a workshop in the field of integrative arts with their national group;
- Culture, art, tourism- related to one of the common areas of learning;

While the general profile features apply to all, the custom profile must show a range that covers at least half (50%) of a country group. Participants are expected to carry out a workshop during the activity, so the appropriate participants in the private profile should also be included.

In addition, priority will be given to disadvantaged youth groups to ensure equal opportunities. A pre-condition for



inclusion of at least 50% disadvantaged young people in the project will be provided by our partners.

WHAT TO BRING:

- Travel documents
- Photocopies of travel documents (in case they get lost, copies speed up the process of issuing new documents)
- Music** (music you like listening to, traditional music etc.) for Intercultural night
- **Food** typical for your country, region, town (optional) for Intercultural night
- Appropriate clothes and shoes, swimsuits - average August temperatures range from 27°C - 32°C as August is the hottest month in Bulgaria.
- You do **NOT** need to bring your own towel as the hotel will provide you with one.

Italy - 275 EUR

Bulgaria- 0 EUR

The venue:

The blended mobility will take place at SPA Hotel Devi, 27 Borislav Street, 4602 Velingrad.

How to get to the venue:

From Sofia airport terminal 2 you have to take the metro until Julio Curie Stop. There you will find Sofia South bus station, where you can catch a bus to Velingrad. VVIF team will meet you at Velingrad bus station and walk with you to the hotel. The distance Sofia-Velingrad is 125 km.

The city:

Velingrad is one of the most popular Bulgarian balneology resorts also known as the SPA capital of the Balkans. It is situated in the picturesque Rhodope Mountain.
